THE DISPOSITION OF THE INDIAN TRIBES INDICATES THAT IT WAS PREPARED SHORTLY BEFORE THE OUTBREAK OF THE YAMASSEE WAR, IN 1715, THOUGH THE "FRENCH FORT" AT THE JUNCTION OF COOSA AND TALLAPOOSA RIVERS WAS PROBABLY BUILT AFTER THAT EVENT, AND THIS FEATURE MAY HAVE BEEN INSERTED LATER. THE ORIGINAL IS IN A SOMEWHAT DAMAGED CONDITION, AND A FEW NAMES OF GREEK TOWNS ON THE ALTAMAHA RIVER AND ITS BRANCHES ARE ILLEGIBLE. THE MAP WAS MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE KINDNESS OF THE SOUTH CAROLINA HISTORICAL SOCIETY.
